ALADDIN: Jafar, help me!

MUSIC STARTS

(While JAFAR cackles, ALADDIN reaches out through the portal and grabs the lamp right out of JAFAR'S greedy little hands. The DEMI-DJINN pull ALADDIN back into the wild chaos of the cave.)

JAFAR: No! I had the lamp in my hands! Curse you, booooooy!

(JAFAR and IAGO vanish as the VENDORS transform the stage into the interior of the Cave of Wonders. ALADDIN is trapped.)
